The 34 year old left the game with a record of 72 England Caps and 63 for England and Newcastle. Daryl has been a member of the Falcons family for his entire career and was an important part of our Heineken Cup success in 2013. Daryl will now work as a consultant at the Falcons and his first task will be to oversee the club’s front office development.” Daryl said: “I am very grateful for all the opportunities that I have had at Newcastle and

for the friends that I have made here, which will always be there for me. Thank you to my family and to the players and supporters who have helped me make such a great career. I am now ready to start a new chapter in my life. I am really excited about the prospect of helping to develop a club that I love and being part of a successful team that we will continue to build.” The Falcons will be welcoming the return of Jonathan Humphreys, who will return to the club for his second spell in a coaching capacity.
